Research field:

Environmental Molecular Biology

We are seeking a candidate who can open new frontiers in environmental biology by studying microorganisms, plants, and/or their associated organisms in the environment. The successful candidate should have expertise in research approaches based on molecular biology, biochemistry, physiology, cell biology, or related fields. We welcome applications from researchers who are motivated to develop new technologies for analyzing environmental biological systems.

Qualifications:

An applicant must have a Ph.D. degree and outstanding research accomplishments in the relevant research fields. An applicant should be passionate about teaching biology, and able to collaborate with other faculty members to conduct cutting-edge, interdisciplinary research and contribute to establishing, maintaining, and developing the research environment.

Term of contract:

5-year contract with the possibility of renewal for one 5-year term (maximum of 10 years in total), determined based on a review of teaching and research achievements.

Probationary period: Three months

Working hours:

The discretionary working system in the type of professional work based on consent (*) or the fixed working hour system will be applied.

* The working hours for a day are deemed as 7 hours 45 minutes.

Salary and allowances:

Compensation based on the National University Corporation Hokkaido University Salary Rules for Faculty Subject to Annual Salary System.

6. Future aspirations in a research career and educational activities (up to 1500 words)
7. Names of two referees with contact details (affiliations and email addresses)
