Associate Professor or Tenure-track Assistant Professor (Number of vacancies: 1), Female only.

3. Educational responsibilities

(Immediately after hiring) Division of Environmental Science Development, Graduate School of Environmental Science (The specific course will be determined in consideration of the wishes and research field of the successful applicant from four courses: Course in Human and Ecological Systems, Course in Environmental Adaptation Science, Course in Practical Science for Environment, and Course in Global Environmental Management) (Scope of change) Duties as determined by the University

4. Research field

Environmental science in a broad sense, including disciplines that can contribute to understanding and solving environmental problems (e.g., ecology, geography, earth science, chemistry, engineering, biology, agriculture, health science, medicine, and social science)

5. Qualifications

Only female (Recruitment of only female faculty members under the provisions of Article 8 of the Equal Employment Opportunity Law). An applicant must have a doctoral degree by the date of appointment. In addition, the applicant has excellent research achievements and leadership skills in the above research fields and can contribute to students' education and research guidance activities in the above educational responsibilities.

6. Employment status

Associate Professor: Tenured

Tenure-track Assistant Professor: The intended tenure-track period is a maximum of five years. The candidate's performance during employment will be evaluated within five years to qualify for a tenured associate professor or non-tenure track assistant professor. An additional term of employment as an assistant professor is limited to five years. A non-tenure track assistant professor is not eligible for tenure review after reappointment.
