INTRODUCTION & SCOPE

The purposes of this symposium are to clarify the nature and ecological features of the tropical peat swamp areas, identify the underlying issues, and find solutions for them. It covers the topics of both basic science and applied issues in five areas of nature and culture, biodiversity and phylogeography, ecosystem characteristics, human impact, and socio-culture and human dimension in tropical peat land.

This is the symposium for synthesis of the past ten-year collaboration between Japan and Indonesia on the tropical peat swamp ecosystems in the island of the hotspot of global biodiversity. The symposium will give the scientific view of less known but important ecosystem using modern techniques and interdisciplinary approach.
