Foreign Language (August 24th; Examinees currently residing abroad: between 19th and 21st August)	Foreign language shall be 'English'. Applicants submitting a TOEFL, TOEIC, or IELTS score are exempted from taking the English examination during the online oral examination. Applicants submitting the score can also take the English examination during the online oral examination. The higher of the two scores will be converted to the English examination result score using a conversion formula specified by the division. Applicants submitting the score are requested to choose if they will take the English examination during the online oral examination when they submit research proposal and PowerPoint file. English examination will be done by PowerPoint presentation (including the short essay for the applicants to the Course in Practical Science for Environment) in English (in part or all) and part (all for applicants to the Course in Global Environmental Management) of the Q & A in English during the online oral examination.
